Nomination:

The competition provides works in the areas described in the Regulations. The volume of abstracts should not exceed 1-2 pages of typewritten text (Times New Roman font, 12 pt., 1 line spacing). The works are accepted in PDF format in Russian or English.

Abstracts include an abstract of up to 100 words, keywords, the purpose of the work, the main idea, proposed solutions, results, their brief discussion and a list of references.

Introduction. A brief overview of the study of the problem in Russia/Africa, research goals and objectives, problem statement.

Methods. A description of specific research methods or methodology, materials and procedures, an analysis of existing solutions, and a concept. Substantiation of the novelty of the research.

Results. The solution proposed by the team for implementation.

Discussion. The point of view and direct research of the author's team. Definition of the UN SDGs (no more than 3), to which the project corresponds. A brief description of the economic, environmental, and social impact.

Conclusion. The main conclusions, assessment of the target audience and the market, adaptation to the conditions of the regions under consideration, the practical significance of the conducted research.

References. The number of literary sources is at least 10. The main number of literary sources should not be older than 5 years. Sources older than 12-15 years are considered outdated. The list of references is formed by reference in the text.
